North Bay Python is a weekend conference for professionals, enthusiasts, and students using the Python programming language. Run in the community-driven tradition of Python conferences (known as PyCons) all around the world, North Bay Python is nonprofit and focused on accessibility, inclusion, diversity, and affordability.

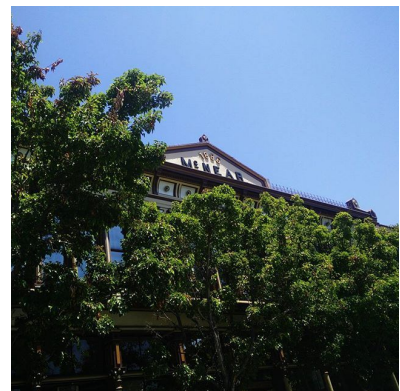
Hosted in Northern California's beautiful North Bay region, less than an hour out of downtown San Francisco, our costs are much lower than a conference in bigger cities. We put our money into making our conference accessible to everyone, by providing financial assistance for our speakers and attendees, childcare for attendees with children, open captioning for people with hearing difficulties, and high quality videos for everyone who can't attend the conference.

North Bay Python is a single-track, expo-free event in a unique performance space. Our talks cover a very wide variety of Python development topics, and teach valuable lessons for developers of all experience levels. We're building on our first year by planning a second memorable conference for the people of the North Bay, the Bay Area, and beyond.

Our Audience

We anticipate more than 300 attendees at our 2018 conference. In 2017, we had 230 attendees from California and beyond, including:

- 78% from the San Francisco Bay Area, including 25% from Sonoma County
- 5% from elsewhere in California
- 17% from other US states, and internationally.



30% of attendees were women or non-binary.

Our attendees range in experience from students and new graduates, through to career professionals with more than 30 years in the industry. Our professional attendees work in many roles, including software engineers, CTO-level executives, DevOps engineers, data scientists, front-end engineers and mobile developers.

48% of our attendees had never attended a Python-focused conference before North Bay Python. 15% of our attendees made North Bay Python their first tech conference.

Package Sponsorship

Package sponsorships are the widest-reaching and best value sponsorships we offer at North Bay Python. When attendees arrive, they'll see your signage as they walk through the door. As they sit in the theatre, they'll see your logo on the backdrop behind the speakers, and on-screen in between talks.
